

Medication Advisory

This advisory applies to all individuals travelling to BP offshore facilities:

Not Permitted

Illegal substances

Drugs or chemicals which are illegal are not permitted.

Unlabelled medication

Medication that is not in the original containers is considered unlabelled. Keep medication in its original packaging and prescriptions in your name.



Luggage search

Unlabelled, concealed, or suspicious substances may be confiscated.

Drug testing

If unlabelled or suspicious substances are found, you will be asked to undergo immediate drug screening prior to boarding. Screening identifies illegal and prescription medications. Any screen that is not negative is sent to the lab for further testing. A physician will review all positive drug tests.

Dangerous and Restricted Medications

Certain medication should not be used offshore due to safety hazards of work, risk for heat illness, living conditions, remoteness from hospital, and the need to be alert for duties during emergencies. These include:

- **blood thinners**
- **nitroglycerin**
- **seizure medication**
- **strong pain medication**
- **muscle relaxers**
- **nerve pain medication**
- **sleeping aids**
- **sedating medication**
- strong **psychiatric** medication
- **chemotherapy**, immunotherapy
- strong corticosteroids (“**steroids**”)
- **weight loss aids**, **Chantix**



Insulin, EpiPen, breathing treatment, and mental stimulants must be pre-approved for use offshore.
