



## TSCA & Employee Medical/Exposure Records

Colleagues,

This communication is in support of the GoM region's annual health, safety and environmental (HSE) notifications regarding access to medical/exposure records and reporting potential health and/or environmental allegations related to BP products.

The Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA) requires bp to inform you of your right to examine and copy medical and/or exposure records relating to your employment. These records are maintained by the GoM Region Health Team for employees. Contractors may contact their company representative for these records.

Also, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), through the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), requires that information about potential adverse health and environmental effects of bp products be reported. Employees and contractors are encouraged to notify the bp TSCA coordinator of any adverse health or environmental concerns related to bp products.
