Who is Required to Have A TWIC Card

33 CFR.101.514 All persons requiring unescorted access into restricted areas must have a TWIC card. All GoM off shore facilities are restricted areas.

BP Off Shore Security Policy: All BP personnel and contractors going to an off-shore facility must have a TWIC card.

Lost or Stolen Cards: 49 CFR 1572.21

- The FSO may grant <u>unescorted access</u> to individuals up to 37 Days provided they have applied for a replacement card
- The individual should take his receipt to the heliport with him

Expired TWIC Cards

There is no provision to grant access if you have let your TWIC card expire. You must reapply and wait until the TWIC card is in your possession to have access

Waivers

The Facility Security Officer (OIM or designee) has sole discretion on providing escorts. Waivers should only be granted to personnel providing specialty services that do not routinely work on the facility and are unable to obtain a TWIC card before scheduled departure.
